Learning outcomes of the Zero Waste Ambassadors program

The learner:

- understands the basics of effective learning and how memory works
- recognises the importance of mistakes and creating possibilities for mistakes in learning situations
- understands how to support long-term learning instead of short-term performance
- understands the importance of the three basic psychological needs of learners
- is able to recognise and support at least some of the basic psychological needs of the learners
- understands why and how misconceptions occur
- knows some methods of how to correct zero waste misconceptions
- understands the limitations and possibilities of learning assessment
- is able to assess the learning outcomes of planned educational activity in general terms
- is able to create learning activities on zero waste topics based on effective learning principles
- is able to adapt to the changes in the learning setting and improvise

Assessment methods used in the programme:

Fullfillment of the learning outcomes was assessed qualitatively by the main trainer through feedback questions and the teaching mini-sessions, where learners had to showcase their aquired competences.
